EXPAND NOW AND INTO THE FUTURE

Located in Narrandera's Redhill Industrial Estate, Hutchins Bros Engineering is a structural steel fabrication business employing 28 staff.

A family business since 1980, Hutchins Bros was established on-farm by brothers Stewart and Graham Hutchins with the intention of building farm sheds. By 1995, Stewart and wife Jenny had moved the business into custom-built premises in Narrandera and branched into major industrial structural steel fabrication.

In 2004, son Bill and his wife Heidi came on board and the two generations worked together to expand the business's market to include metropolitan areas until Stewart and Jenny retired in 2011.

While working in Sydney as a rigger erecting structural steel, Bill first became aware that the steel Hutchins Bros was producing back home in Narrandera was far superior to the steel he was working with in Sydney and moved on the opportunity

Since then, the business has not looked back – developing strong industry alliances and providing the entire structural steel package, from design and shop detailing, through to fabrication, finishing and erection.

Hutchins Bros has forged strong relationships with the Australia's tier 1 builders such as John Holland, Lend Lease, CPB Contractors and Laing O'Rourke.

The business has also had particular success in delivering infrastructure works to the Department of Defence.

In 2008, the firm's expansion required relocation to a new 18,000sqm facility at Redhill Industrial Estate.

"Being located in Narrandera on the intersection of two major highways, makes it easy for us to service the Melbourne, Sydney and Canberra metropolitan areas.

"We are also blessed with our space. We can fabricate and store products for our clients on tight sites, where deliveries are required on an as-needs basis, a luxury that many of our metropolitan competitors cannot afford or offer.

"Since we moved out here, we've bought the adjoining block and we're also looking to extend our premises. Being here gives us the flexibility to do that.

"Moving to Redhill Industrial Estate would be a good proposition for any business that's looking for expansion now, but also into the future."
