Entry is free however expressions of interest are required to receive the koala shape. Please base your design on this shape as it will give the businesses who will be commissioning the artwork on the Koala Art Trail sculptures a good indication of what your design will look like. - 7. The artworks must use the Koala Sculpture Shape as provided and must have been solely the work of the entrant or entrants (if a group design is entered). There is no limit to the number of entries each entrant can submit.
